



Job Opening: Education Advocacy Associate

A Red Circle, located in north St. Louis County, Missouri, exists to address the link between systemic racism and regional economic health in North County. Our mission is "the holistic betterment of our community, reversing the effects of racism one person and cause at a time." Our programs are created based on community-voiced needs, and community members are never restricted to a single need.

The Education Advocacy Associate will work alongside the Education Advocacy Director. The Education Advocacy Associate will manage special projects to include supporting a pool of student Interns in various academic disciplines; ensuring the success of the students and/or families involved.

This expansion of our Education Advocacy program requires the addition of an Education Advocacy Associate in the Hazelwood and Ferguson-Florissant School Districts. The Education Advocacy Associate would intensively support field interns/trainees working with at risk students to stay in school (referred by school districts or social service agencies). Interns/Trainees will assess students academically, tutor one-on-one, advocate with school personnel and SSD, provide support for trauma-related behavior and learning issues, support parents, and refer parents/students to other services as needed.

Skills Needed: Interpersonal, organizational, ability to follow-up, professionalism, communication, MS Office software, general computer knowledge, commitment to antiracism and the most vulnerable students.

Successful background check required, including approval through E Verify.
