Education

- **Education Advocacy Coalition** – community stakeholders come together to address policy concerns around education and student success.
- **Student Advocates for Education** – S.A.F.E. workers advocate for students in pre-K through 5th grade to address the root causes of certain behaviors to help kids avoid suspension and detention.
- **Parent Café** – monthly workshops designed for parents of school-age children cover the Five Protective Factors, IEPs, and more.
- **Sundae Stories** - weekly summer literacy program where children enjoy stories read by community narrators while savoring ice cream, creating joyful memories and fostering a love for reading.

Arts

- **Chosen Pathways** - summer youth internship that explores careers in art.
- **Art in the Garden** - decorate our growing spaces and create art projects to take home.
- **Meet A Red Circle at The Muny** - families gather at The Muny in Forest Park for a great show.
- **Drumming For Peace** - a week-long summer camp, held at The Creative Spot, where children explore the history of African drumming, music theory, and peace within their worlds.

Community Wellness

- **Good Food Fridays** - residents build community and receive fresh produce, recipes, and nutrition information.
- **Healthy Community Market** - affordable farmer’s market, cooking demos, fitness activities, resources, and health vendors.
- **God’s Bounty** - brings healthy food and garden instruction into North County churches.
- **Food & Justice Fellowship** - 9-month, paid opportunity for students to learn business, policy, and growing as each relates to the food system.
